Training at Pimlico on Black-Eyed Susan Day, Friday May 17, will be 5:30am-9:30am, no break.

Training at Laurel on Black-Eyed Susan Day, Friday, May 17, will be 5:30am-9:30am, break at 7:00am.

Training at Pimlico on Preakness Day, Saturday, May 18, will be from 5:00am-6:00am. Only horses racing Preakness Day are permitted to train on this day. You must get permission from Terry Overmier to get onto the racetrack.

Training at Laurel on Preakness Day, Saturday, May 18, will be from 5:30am-8:30am. No break and no schooling.

No training at Pimlico Race Course or Laurel Park on Sunday, May 19.

Special Post Times

Black-Eyed Susan Day 11:30am

Preakness Day 10:30am

Black-Eyed Susan and Preakness Day No Horse Vans or Trailers will be permitted access to the Hayward Ave. Stable Gate (behind the grandstand) after 7:00am on Black-Eyed Susan Day and Preakness Day. You will be turned around and sent to the Pimlico Rd. Stable Gate.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN:

Everyone must wear their MRC Racing License on the outside of their clothing.

PREAKNESS, BLACK-EYED SUSAN, AND UAE PRESIDENT CUP HORSE MUST BE AT PIMLICO 72 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR RESPECTIVE RACE.

All other graded and listed stakes horses MUST be at an approved training or racing facility 72 hours prior to race day. There local Officials/Reg-Vets will cooperatively monitor those horses training and will submit regular veterinary exams to the TSG Chief Veterinary Officer.

All other stake and non-stake horses MUST be on the grounds no later than 7:00am race day. Horses assigned training towels must wear them during training beginning 72 hours prior to race day.

Entry Requirements:

Trainer will not enter a horse in any race on Black-Eyed Susan Day or Preakness Day UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by Trainer's Attending Veterinarian once during the three (3) days immediately preceding the entry to race for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to race; and (b) been found fit to race by the Attending Veterinarian. This evaluation shall include, at a minimum, palpation and passive flexion of the forelimbs and watching the horse jog. The Attending Veterinarian must submit a verification of examination and fitness to race to the 1/ST Racing Chief Veterinary Officer at dionne.benson@stronachgroup.com. If no verification is submitted the horse will be scratched. The Attending Veterinarian and trainer are obligated to inform the Chief Veterinary Officer of any changes in the horse's fitness after entry and before race day.

Shoe Rule:

DIRT: Front hooves are permitted 2 millimeters or less full rims (no raised toes); Hind hooves are permitted 4 millimeters or less full rims or toe grabs up to 4 millimeters in height.

TURF: Traction devices are prohibited on both front and hind hooves. Traction devices include but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar caulks, and stickers.

LASIX POLICY:

ALL stake races run at Laurel and Pimlico will be run without the use of Lasix. ALL two-year-old races will continue to be run

without the use of Lasix.

MJC will no longer be accepting blood drawn slips for coggins.
The coggins MUST come back negative and turned into Horse
ID. Must be within 365 days of the date the blood was drawn.
